## WHAT IS A ULID?

A **U**tility **L**ocal **I**mprovement District is the procedure used to extend sewer service to a group of properties whereby all property owners share in the cost. The process is a formal State defined procedure.

## WHO STARTS A ULID?

- A petition signed by owners of at least 51% of the land area within the limits of the proposed **ULID**.


OR

- A Resolution of intention to form a **ULID** passed by the Board of Commissioners of the District.

## WHAT WILL STOP THE ULID FORMATION?

1. The formation of a **ULID** by petition will not proceed if the petition signatures, once certified, are not sufficient.

OR

2. The formation of a **ULID** by District Resolution will not proceed if owners of 40% of the area object in writing to the Board of District Commissioners during the formation hearing process.

## HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

- Generally, from initiation to completion, it takes 6 months.


## HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

- The cost is based on the actual cost for construction. This will include engineering, administration and construction. Each **ULID** is unique and the cost will vary.

## WHAT OTHER COSTS ARE THERE?\*

- Sewer Connection Permit \$110.00
- Sewer Connection Charge \$1,898.00
- Regional Facility Charge \$4,444.00 (Salmon Creek Treatment Plant Only)
- Monthly Service Charge \$34.00 (Billed bi-monthly whether connected or not to cover maintenance of lines)
- Installation of the line on individual property, from property line to house connection
- Pumping and abandoning septic tank

\*All costs are current as of 1/07 and subject to revision.

## HOW IS THE ULID FINANCED?

1. Cash within 30 days of notification (following construction) without any interest.

OR

2. Annual installments, plus interest.

## SUMMARY


⇒ **ULID's** are formed by petition or resolution

⇒ **ULID's** are financed by the District through Bonds

⇒ **ULID's** are paid for by cash or in annual installments

⇒ **ULID's** costs vary depending on location, etc.

⇒ **ULID's** generally take 6 months to complete.
