Construction to Start on NE 20th Avenue Sewer Pipeline Project

Vancouver, WA – The Clark Regional Wastewater District (District) is preparing to start construction on the NE 20th Avenue Sewer Pipeline project. The project will support continued growth and economic development along the I-5 Discovery Corridor, including the City of Ridgefield. The project is being constructed by Rotschy, Inc. of Vancouver, Washington. Construction is scheduled to begin mid-October, and the sewer pipeline completed in summer of 2023 with final landscaping work wrapping up later in the fall.

Construction of the sewer pipeline is expected to start at the intersection of NE 139th St and NE 20th Ave and will proceed in a Northerly direction. Construction activities along NE 20th Avenue are expected to last nine months and will impact traffic. Work will generally occur in the daytime and will be located in the center of the roadway, maintaining an open lane of traffic in both directions. The travelling public can expect daytime closures of the center turn lane and adjacent travel lane(s) along with isolated nighttime lane closures. Left turns will not be allowed across active construction areas.

Construction activities along NE 139th St and across Walgreens are expected to last for two weeks and will be completed at night to limit impacts to the travelling public and neighboring businesses. The travelling public can expect nighttime lane closures in NE 139th St. Traffic lanes will be reopened each morning. Access to Walgreens' drive-through pharmacy will remain open throughout construction.

The NE 20th Avenue sewer project will construct approximately 3,700 feet of new 30-inch diameter sewer and is designed to provide wastewater capacity for the next 50 years. Following construction of the new sewer pipe, services will be transferred, and the existing sewer line will be abandoned. Existing sewer services will remain in operation during construction. The existing sewer conveys approximately 2 million-gallons-per-day of wastewater and ranges in pipe size from 10-inches to 18-inches in diameter.
