How does your agency determine a responsible bidder with a responsive bid? Responsible bidder determinations are made in conformance with Washington state law and District Code (www.crwwd.com/district-code/) Section 2.32.060. Supplemental bidder responsibility criteria, if applicable, are listed in the solicitation documents. The determination includes but is not limited to evaluating criteria such as the bidder's registration, industrial insurance coverage, and eligibility to bid on public works projects in the state.

What, if any, rosters is your agency currently using? How do I register? The District utilizes the statewide small works roster, administered by MRSC Rosters, for vendor registration. To register, visit www.mrscrosters.org and select Clark Regional Wastewater District in your account. Registration is free and ensures eligibility for upcoming projects.
